If your WGS data has already been generated or will be generated outside of the CCGP Mini-Core, it is your responsibility to share raw resequencing data and the associated metadata for all of the resequencing samples with the CCGP Bioinformatics team.

Projects that already have samples in hand should be working to generate and submit sequencing data regardless of whether they have completed sample sets. Projects planning on utilizing the CCGP Mini-Core can submit sample sets of roughly half or more of their planned samples. We encourage submission of partial sequencing data sets to help move the project forward.
